Dear Parents / Caregivers

We appreciate your support as parents and particularly for those who were previously 100% remote, to send your children in for these exams.

COVID Update

You all received the update about COVID cases across the Academy earlier this week. We continue to monitor these diligently and attend to the basics of personal and collective health and safety. A few reminders for families:

- The value of hand hygiene and safe practices around coughing and sneezing
- If you have any concern that symptoms are present in you or family members, err on side of caution, contact school or medical staff for advice
- If your children are isolated as close contacts, they must follow the advice sent to you from our medical staff

Please be aware we are in constant communication with DHA and are aware of the guidelines around such decisions. Yesterday the limits were exceeded in Year 1 and that is why we have isolated that year group.
