<u>Step 1 – Online Application:</u>

Step 2 – Documentation:

Once you have filled out the online form you will be prompted to upload the minimum required documents to process the application. Please disclose any special needs / support requirements at the start of the admission process. WSO is an inclusive school however we are currently at **Full Capacity** for students who require Additional Learning Support / Shadow Teacher. We have limited capacity for students who require **English Language Support**.

<u>Step 3 – Principal Review & Securing Admission:</u>

Once the minimum required documents have been uploaded to the student profile, we will arrange an assessment. The completed file will be reviewed by the principal. Based on principal feedback we will conditionally offer. The offer will be valid for 3-7 days (depending on availability). To secure the admission parents would need to pay a 10% registration deposit (calculated on the yearly fees). This fee is nonrefundable however is <u>adjustable</u> against the first term fees.

Step 4 - Class Allocation:

Prior to confirming class allocation, ALL students are required to complete an age-appropriate observation/assessment.

Foundation Stage: Attend 15 to 20min Stay and Play Observation.

Year 1 & 2: Face to Face written test (English and Math). Year 3 and older: <u>Cognitive Ability Test</u> (CAT4)

Transfer Certificate (TC) Guide:

<u>A</u>: If you are moving within the Dubai School Network – You need a TC from your previous School. <u>B</u>: If you are moving from overseas and applying for YR3 and older you will need a TC.

Every student meeting the above requirements must produce a Transfer Certificate (TC) from their last school. UAE Ministry of Education strictly enforce this rule. Failure to produce a properly completed certificate, or a legally binding undertaking to produce all the necessary documentation, will result in your child's place being withdrawn. Please discuss your child's transfer certificate requirements with the Registrar, as your country of origin and last school is taken into consideration.

Transfer Certificate Requirements:

- The Transfer Certificate (TC) must be on an official school letterhead.
- It must be signed by the Principal and show an official school stamp.
- The original certificate must be presented <u>prior</u> to the first day of school.
- The certificate must be in either English or Arabic.

The original Transfer Certificate (TC) must contain the following information:

- 1. Full Name of Child
- 2. Date of Birth
- 3. Commencement Date at School
- 4. Grade/Class on Leaving
- 5. Leaving Date at School
- 6. Curriculum Used (12 Year or 13 Year)
- 7. Must have wording that confirms the student has been "Promoted To"/ "Currently attending"

Important Attestation Instructions

Children coming from countries other than America, Australia, Canada, Europe should have the original Transfer Certificate (TC) attested by:

- Ministry of Education (from country of TC origin)
- Ministry of Foreign Affairs (from country of TC origin)
- UAE Embassy (from country of TC origin)

Children coming from South and Central America, Asia, Russia and former Russian States, Eastern Europe, Africa and New Zealand must have their original Transfer Certificate (TC) :

- School principal's signature and school stamp included
- Attestation by the Ministry of Education in the country of origin.
- Attestation by UAE Consulate or Embassy in the origin country <u>OR</u> by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the UAE.

Eastern Europe includes :- <u>Belarus, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary</u>, <u>Poland</u>, <u>Moldova</u>, <u>Romania</u>, <u>Russia</u>, <u>Slovakia</u>, and <u>Ukraine</u>.

Children coming from Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Bahrain, Qatar and Oman must have their **original** certificates attested **only** by the Ministry of Education (from country of TC origin).

For students transferring from schools within the UAE, a Ministry of Education approved Transfer Certificate is issued.

NB: The corresponding year group is of vital importance. The Ministry of Education may refuse the child entry if the year group does not correspond with that of the new school year group placement. Children from overseas will be placed as per age only in FS1 to Year 2 as per KHDA guidelines.





Booster pads and child seats will be charged at AED 300 per seat per student. The transport fee is applicable and charged for the academic year. Full payment for each term must be made irrespective of the number of school days or usage and this applies to exam periods. • Transport fees are required to be paid in advance to activate the student ID card and the student ID is required to travel on the bus. All ID cards must be activated for registration and insurance of bus journeys. If any transport fees are not paid by the 10th of the first month of the new term, the student ID card will be deactivated, and the student will not be permitted to travel on the bus until fee payment has been made. We reserve the right to change any associated transport service fees without notice. For further information regarding school transport, please refer to the Terms and Conditions



Bus Club:

All children who need to access these facilities due to catching the Academy transport will be able to do so without the need for signing up. However, a student must catch the first bus home available after their finish time - we cannot allow a child to wait for a later bus when an earlier one is available. Due to the young age of FS1 students we cannot allow them to wait until the last service, even if they have a sibling on the 3.30pm service.


